Certificate entitlement

This application form can only be used if the marriage occurred in NSW. If you are either partner in the marriage, the certificate can be issued to you. If you are a child of the marriage, the certificate can be issued to you if both partners are deceased. If you are not a child of the marriage, but need to establish your legal right or entitlement, e.g. under a Will, your application will be considered.

- Three forms of ID from the person giving permission (see below).
- Three forms of your own ID (see below).
